Key Responsibilities:

 - Spray painting including surface preparation, masking, painting, and lacquering
 - Protecting and packing finished products
 - Loading and unloading vans
 - Keeping the workshop facility as a clean and safe place to work.

The role can be labour intensive, particularly when loading and unloading trucks/vans. Although our processes use lifting aids including an electric pedestrian pallet stacker, you will need to be comfortable lifting up to 20 kg repeatedly. To be chosen for this role, you will be reliable and hardworking, with a flexible can-do attitude. And share our clients interest in recycling and reducing waste.

Essential skills and qualifications:

- Experience and, ideally, trained in a related trade (e.g. carpentry, fitting, engineering, spray painting, handyman, furniture manufacture)
- Willing and able to learn to use specialised tools, equipment and techniques in line with our remanufacturing techniques
- Able to work varied hours, which may include occasional work out-of-hours, weekends, or away for the working week on a client site
- This is a physical role so you must be capable of lifting objects repeatedly during the loading and unloading process
- Eligible to work in the UK
